B. REQUEST FOR TEMPORARY STREET CLOSURE TO HOLD A BLOCK PARTY

Street Closure Approved

A request for temporary street closure has been submitted for the purpose of holding a block party on Saturday, July 4, 2009 as follows:

- 300 block of Bridge Street from Sycamore to Coolidge Elementary School from 2:00 to 8:00 p.m.

Recommended Action: That the Council approve the request subject to the following conditions:

- (1) A minimum width of 20 feet of one side of the street shall remain unobstructed for access by public safety vehicles.
- (2) Fire hydrants shall remain unobstructed at all times.
- (3) There shall be no consumption of alcohol within the public right-of-way.
- (4) There shall be no fireworks or other pyrotechnic displays.
- (5) A resident shall be identified as the responsible party for all contacts by City agencies and for installing and removing the street barricades.
- (6) Parties are subject to disturbing the peace laws.
- (7) The street closure shall be between the hours as indicated on the request form.

C. 2009 KID'S DAY AND 4TH OF JULY PARADE – REQUESTED CLOSURE OF MISSION DRIVE

Resolution 09-19 Approved

City of San Gabriel staff, in conjunction with a volunteer committee, will be holding the third annual Kid's Day and 4th of July Parade on Saturday, July 4, 2009 in the Mission District.

Staff is requesting a staged street closure of Mission Drive from Las Tunas on the north, to Mission Road on the south beginning at 8:00 a.m. until all parade participants have reached Plaza. Mission Drive will remain closed south of the intersection of Santa Anita Street to Mission Road until the picnic is completed.

Recommended Action: That the City Council:

- (1) Adopt Resolution No. 09-19 temporarily closing Mission Drive from Las Tunas Drive to Mission Road on Saturday, July 4, 2009 at 8:00a.m.
- (2) Approve use of Plaza Park (set-up and picnic) from 6:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.
- (3) Approve use of the Mission Playhouse and City Hall parking lots beginning at 8:00 a.m. for parking.
