At the August 16, 2005 meeting, the subject ordinance was approved on the first reading by a vote of 4-1 that prohibits parking on the street from 2-6 a.m. Ordinance 556-C.S. is being presented for adoption on second reading.

Councilmember Sawkins moved to adopt Ordinance 556-C.S.; seconded by Councilmember Gutierrez. The motion passed by a vote on the board of four yes with Mayor Costanzo voting no.

In conjunction with the budget process, staff reviewed the City Council's salary and is recommending a cost of living increase that is provided for by the Government Code and would not be effective until March 20, 2007.
