## NEW BUSINESS

**1. PLANNING CASE PL-06-035 (Tentative Tract Map and Variance)  
1635 S. Del Mar Avenue  
Applicant: Hing Wah Lee**

This application is for approval of a Tentative Tract Map and three Variances. The tentative tract map will subdivide the building airspace for commercial and residential uses. The project is a mixed-use development consisting of 21,518 sq. ft. of retail, restaurant and office uses on the first and second floors, 21 residential condominium units on floors 2-6 and three levels of underground parking. Three variances are requested to permit: (1) the building to be six stories in lieu of the maximum four stories; (2) a freestanding sign at a height of 46 feet in lieu of the maximum 20 feet; and (3) a sign area of 448 square feet per side in lieu of the maximum 50 square feet per side permitted by code. The project is located in the Valley Boulevard Mixed Use Transit Oriented Development (MU-T) zone.

Environmental Determination: The project was reviewed for compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). A Mitigated Negative Declaration of Environmental Impact has been prepared and is available for review.

Recommended Action: That, after hearing public testimony, the Planning Commission (1) approves the Tentative Tract Map and Variance for the building height; and (2) denies the Variances for the freestanding sign.
