## Fire Department Fees

Type of Fee	Current Fee	Explanation
Burning Permit (open fire pit for cooking)	\$110.00	To conduct open burning. Where burning is conducted on public property.
Candles and Open flames in Assembly Areas	\$110.00	A permit to use an open flame or candles in connection with assembly areas, dining areas, restaurants or drinking establishments.
Carnivals and Fairs	\$110.00	A permit to conduct a carnival or fair.
Christmas Tree Lots	\$110.00	To conduct fire inspections.
Fireworks - Public Display	\$200.00	To provide a permit for public fireworks displays.
Flammable or Combustible Liquids	\$150.00	A permit to remove Class I or Class II liquids from underground storage tanks for fueling motor vehicles.
Flammable or Combustible Liquids	\$110.00 (per tank)	A permit to install, alter, remove, abandon, place temporarily or permanently out of service or otherwise dispose of a flammable or combustible liquid tank.
Liquified Petroleum Gases	\$110.00	A permit to store, use or dispense LP-gas or to install or maintain LP-gas containers. (includes up to one hour of inspection time)
Motor Vehicle Fuel Dispensing Stations	\$110.00	A permit to dispense flammable or combustible liquids, liquified petroleum gases or compressed natural gas at motor vehicle fuel-dispensing stations.
Places of Assembly - Occupant Load 50-300	\$110.00	A permit is required to operate or maintain, as described in Article 9.
Places of Assembly - Occupant Load 301-5,000	\$250.00	A permit is required to operate or maintain, as described in Article 9.
Places of Assembly - Occupant Load over 5,000	\$325.00	A permit is required to operate or maintain, as described in Article 9.
Pyrotechnic Special Effects Material	\$110.00	A permit for pyrotechnical special effects materials.
Tents, Canopies and Temporary Membrane Structures	\$110.00	A permit to erect or operate a tent or air-supported temporary membrane structure having an area in excess of 200 square feet or a canopy in excess of 400 square feet, except for structures used exclusively for camping.
Fire Alarm System	\$150.00 (plus 1.25 per device)	To review and approve plans required life safety systems.
Fire Extinguishing System	\$150.00 (plus 1.50 per point)	To plan check a kitchen hood system.
Commercial Occupancies	\$300.00	To plan check a commercial sprinkler system. (includes one re-submittal)
Commercial Occupancies (tenant improvement)	\$150.00	To plan check a commercial tenant improvement sprinkler system. (includes one re-submittal)
Residential Occupancies	\$150.00	To plan check a residential sprinkler system. (includes one re-submittal)
Underground piping/Private Fire Hydrant	\$150.00	To plan check underground piping and/or private fire hydrant. (includes one re-submittal)
Spray Booth	\$110.00	A permit to operate a mechanically ventilated appliance or varying dimensions and construction provided to enclose or accommodate a spraying operation and to confine and limit the escape or spray vapor or residue and to exhaust it safely.
Tank (removal of underground tank(s) )	\$110.00 (per tank)	A permit to remove or abandon any underground tank use in connection with flammable or combustible liquids or other hazardous materials.
Tank (removal of contents of tank)	\$110.00 (per tank)	A permit to remove Class I or Class II liquids from an underground storage tank used for fueling motor vehicles by any means other than the approved, stationary on-site pumps normally used for dispensing purposes.
Tank (instalation of underground tank(s) )	\$110.00 (per tank)	A permit to install, upgrade or alter equipment in connection with the storage, handling, use or sale of flammable or combustible liquids, or other hazardous materials regulated under the code.
False Alarms	\$430.00	The reporting of an alarm for which no such fire or emergency actually exists. After the third false alarm response within a twelve-month period a charge is assessed to the property owner.
Re-inspections	\$110.00	To conduct a re-inspection.
Fire Reports	\$20.00	To obtain a copy of a record of a fire occurring within the jurisdiction and of facts concerning the same.
Fire Investigations	\$110.00	The Fire Department is authorized to investigate promptly the cause, origin and circumstances or each and every fire occurring in the jurisdiction involving loss of life or injury to person or destruction or damage to property. Price is per hour.
