Type of Fee	Current Fee	Explanation
Automobile Wrecking Yard	\$110.00	A permit to operate an automobile wrecking yard.
Bowling Pin or Alley	\$110.00	A permit to conduct a bowling pin refinishing or bowling alley resurfacing operation.
Compressed Gases	\$110.00	A permit to store compressed gas mixtures consisting of two or more compressed gases contained in a packaging, the hazard properties of which are represented by the mixture as a whole.
Dry Cleaning Plants	\$110.00	A permit to engage in the business of dry cleaning or change to a more hazardous cleaning solvent.
Fire Hydrants and Water-Control Valves	\$110.00	A permit for the use of a fire hydrant or to operate a water-control valve intended for fire-suppression purposes.
Flammable or Combustible Liquids	\$110.00	A permit to store, handle or use Class I liquids in excess of 5 gallons in a building or in excess of 10 gallons outside of a building.
Flammable or Combustible Liquids	\$110.00	A permit to store or use Class I liquids in the fuel tank of a motor vehicle, aircraft, motorboat, mobile power plant or mobile heating plant.
Flammable or Combustible Liquids	\$110.00	A permit to change the type of contents stored in a flammable combustible liquid tank to a material other than that for which it was designed and constructed.
Flammable or Combustible Liquids	\$110.00	A permit to store or use paints, oils, varnishes or similar flammable mixtures when such liquids are stored for maintenance, painting or similar purposes for a period of not more than 30 days.
High-Piled Combustible Storage	\$150.00	A permit to use any building or portion thereof as a high-piled storage area exceeding 500 square feet.
Multi-Story	\$150.00	A permit to maintain or operate a high-rise building. To recover costs and offset the expenses of staff time to conduct safety and/or compliance inspections.
Magnesium Working	\$110.00	A permit to melt, cast, heat, treat or grind more than 10 pounds of magnesium per working day.
Ovens, Industrial Baking or Drying	\$110.00	A permit to operate an industrial baking or drying system.
Refrigeration Equipment	\$110.00	A permit to install or operate a mechanical refrigeration unit or system containing more than 220 pounds of Group A1 or 30 pounds of any other group refrigerant.
Repair Garages	\$110.00	A permit to use a structure as a place of business for servicing or repairing motor vehicles.
Spraying or Dipping	\$110.00	A permit to conduct a spraying or dipping operation utilizing flammable or combustible liquids or the application of combustible powders.
Welding and Cutting Operation	\$110.00	A permit to conduct welding or cutting operations in an occupancy.
Life Safety Systems for Mid-Rise and High-Rise Buildings	\$500.00 (plus 1.25 per device)	To review and approve plans for required life safety systems.
Dip Tank	\$110.00	A permit for a tank, vat or container of flammable or combustible liquid which articles are immersed or the purpose of coating, finishing, treating or similar processes.
Conduct Fire Flow Testing	\$110.00	To conduct fire flow testing.
Business Inspection	\$110.00	To conduct fire clearance inspection for use and occupancy permit.
Convalescent Hospitals, Sanitariums and Mental Hospitals	\$110.00	To conduct life safety inspections.
Homes for the Ambulatory Aged and Homes for Ambulatory Children Six Years or Older	\$110.00	To conduct life safety inspections.
Acute Hospitals, Less than 100 Beds	\$110.00	To conduct life safety inspections.
Acute Hospitals, 100 Beds or More	\$150.00	To conduct life safety inspections.
Large Family Day Care, 7-12 persons	\$110.00	To conduct life safety inspections.
Day Care Accommodating Six or less	\$110.00	To conduct life safety inspections.
Medical Office Clearance	\$110.00	To conduct fire insurance inspections.
Boarding Homes	\$110.00	To conduct life safety inspections.
Schools - Private	\$110.00	To conduct life safety inspections.
Technical Reports	\$110.00	To provide a technical report. Price per hour.
