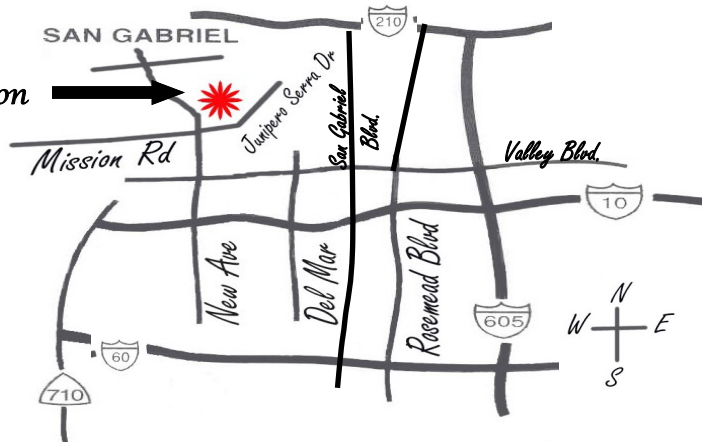
Free Registration

Come be part of the spirit of Los Angeles' original settlers, "Los Pobladores - Walk to Los Angeles". Ten years after the San Gabriel Mission was established in 1771 the Pobladores traveled west to settle Los Angeles. You will follow in the footsteps of the original settlers from San Gabriel Mission, along what is now known as Mission Road, to the settlement they established - El Pueblo de la Reina de Los Angeles (Olvera Street).

From the 10 San Bernardino Freeway

Exit New Avenue, go north 1.25 miles staying in the right lane (New Avenue becomes Ramona). Follow signs to the Mission District. Plaza Park is next to the San Gabriel Mission.

From the 210 Freeway

Exit San Gabriel Blvd, go south. Turn right on Las Tunas Dr & left on Mission Drive. Plaza Park is next to the San Gabriel Mission.

In addition to available on-street parking, Public Parking is available at the San Gabriel Mission Playhouse and San Gabriel City Hall.

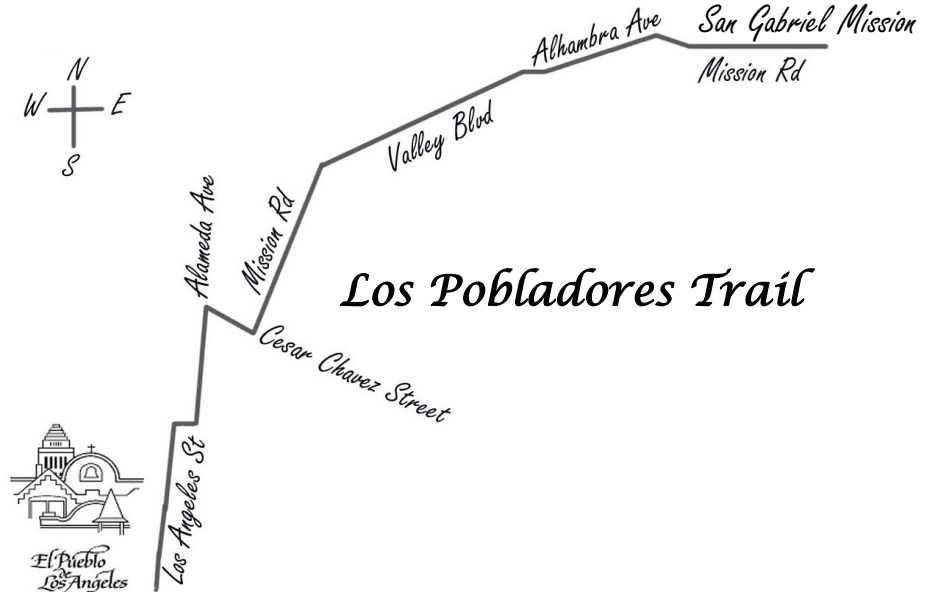
The Trail

Starting at Plaza Park you will walk along Mission Road (west). **Walkers MUST walk on the sidewalk and follow all traffic laws that apply to pedestrians.** The route to Los Angeles is approximately nine miles and takes three hours. The trail ends in Los Angeles at El Pueblo Historical Monument (Olvera Street). Can't make the entire nine miles? Then start at Lincoln Park to walk the last three miles!

Restrooms are available in San Gabriel, Lincoln Park, and throughout El Pueblo Historic Monument.
