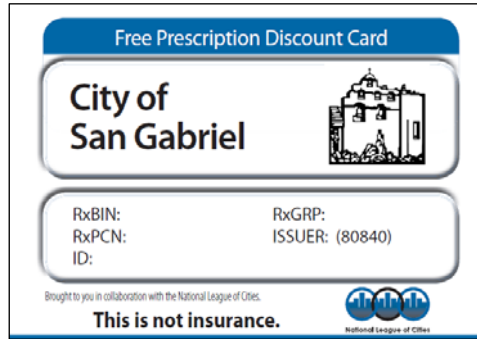


Save on Prescription Drugs...



With our new Prescription Discount Card!

The City of San Gabriel has a new program to offer savings on prescription drugs to residents who are without health insurance, a traditional benefits plan, or have prescriptions that are not covered by insurance.

The **Prescription Discount Card** is made available to residents by the City of San Gabriel in collaboration with the National League of Cities (NLC) and is made possible through the City of San Gabriel's membership in NLC.

The card is **FREE to all San Gabriel residents**, regardless of age, income or existing health insurance. By using this card you **may save an average of 20%** off the regular retail price of prescription drugs at participating pharmacies.
