GETTING THERE

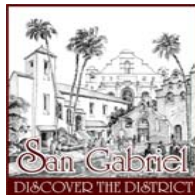
From the 210 Freeway:

Bear right onto Santa Anita Ave.

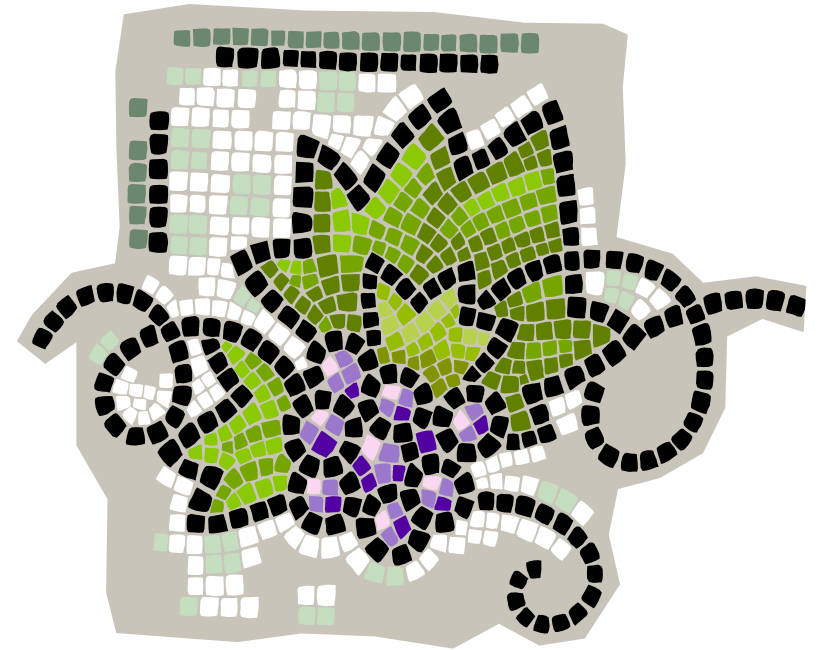
From the 10 Freeway:
