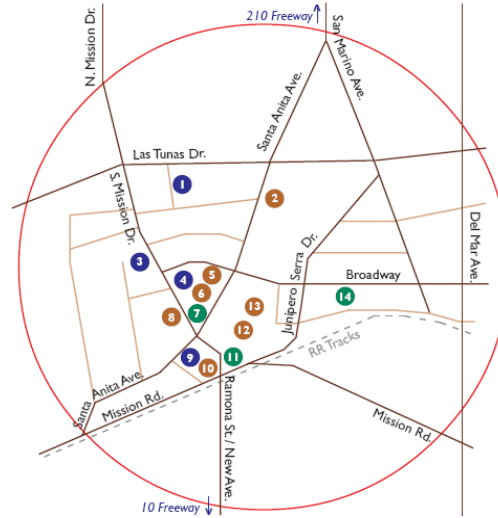


GETTING THERE

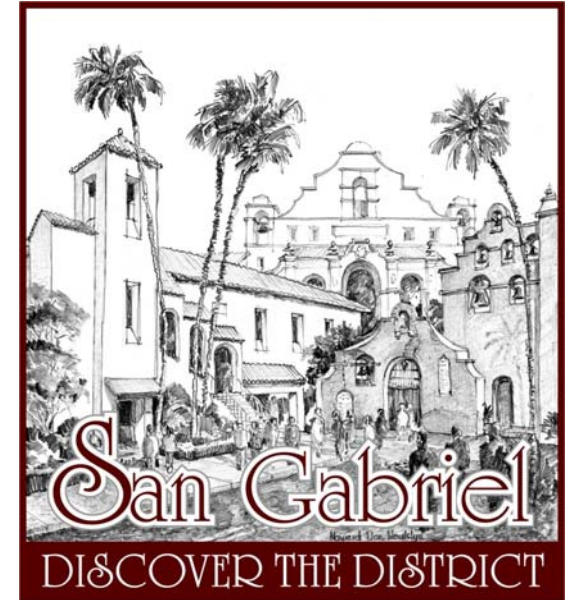
